WHY PRIVATE TUITION?

Most parents and students are not fully aware of the particulars of private tuitions for Std. XII and MHT-CET. However, tuitions for Std. XII are very different from those for Std. X. As far as we know, there are two principal differences between these two.

- At Std. X level, a single teacher teaches all the three Science subjects (viz. Physics, Chemistry, and Biology). Same teachers teach Physics as well as Mathematics. In addition to this there are other combinations, too.

At Std. XII+MHT-CET level, each teacher specialises in a single subject, in fact, even in the particular paper of the given subject i.e. Paper I or Paper II.

- In Std. X, there are fewer number of students per batch about 4 to 10 students vis-a-vis the 15 to 30 in Std. XII.

You must also know that there are two types of private tuitions for Std. XII+MHT-CET:

- Those conducted by almost all reputed coaching classes in addition to their regular batches.
- Those conducted by individual professors.

This prospectus is regarding Private Tuitions conducted by Kalrashukla Classes and NOT by individual professors.

The lectures will be taken by a team of highly qualified, disciplined and dedicated professors for each subject from our institute, including Prof. M. H. Kalra and Prof. R. D. Shukla.

ADVANTAGES

- Only 20 students per batch.
- Convenient time-table (Student preferences will be taken into consideration).
- More number of tests (approx. 50 for each subject).
- The test timings are phased in such a manner that the students will be able to prepare efficiently for all the tests in a single day.

LECTURE FREQUENCY

Phase I, II and IV: Sundays, Public Holidays and during College Vacations.

For PCMB, there will be 4 lectures every day. For PCM, there

will be 3 lectures every day. Each lecture will be of 90 minutes duration.

Phase III: Weekdays: 2 lectures per day, either in the morning (6:45 am to 9:55 am) or in the evening (6:00 pm to 9:10 pm). 4 Lectures per day on Sundays and Public Holidays.

Batches will be decided as per college theory and practical time-tables, and are based on the data forms issued to students for ascertaining their respective college timings. The time-table for this phase is made only a week after colleges open.

Phase V: Each day 2 Lectures (Revision and Doubt Solving)

Note: The timings for coaching in any of the above mentioned groups is either 6:45 am to 1:30 pm OR 2:00 pm to 8:40 pm. At most of the centers, we have both the timings for all four groups; while, at some centers, we may have only morning or only afternoon batches. Hence, we take preference from students about timings. You will find a column regarding this in the admission form. Whether the group timings at a particular centre is morning or afternoon, will be communicated to the students at least 1 week prior to the commencement of course. While we would not like to cause inconvenience to students / parents, in case it is imperative, then parents and students must cooperate.

ADVANTAGES OF KALRASHUKLA'S PRIVATE TUTIONS OVER TUTIONS CONDUCTED BY INDIVIDUAL PROFESSORS

1. All the tuitions will be conducted at the same address.

When students take tuitions from individual professors, they have to travel from one place to another, thereby wasting their valuable time and energy.

2. If due to some unforeseen circumstances, one professor is unable to take a lecture in a particular batch, another professor will take over that time-slot and hence re-substitution will be done. Thus, the schedule will be maintained.

On the other hand, if the same thing occurs in case of a single professor teaching the entire subject, the lecture is cancelled and leads to a waste of time and energy.

3. As teaching is done by a team of professors, it is possible to complete the entire syllabus much earlier.

As against this, in private tuitions conducted by individual professors, the syllabus is mostly completed around December or early January.

4. Most of the individual professors do not prepare progress

report of the students; instead they focus on students' progress only in the particular subject they teach. Contrary to this, in private tuitions conducted by our institute, we have the infrastructure and management to track and monitor students' performance in all subjects, enabling us to guide the students better.

5. In private tuitions conducted by us, professors have to be punctual, regular and disciplined, whereas in tuitions by individual professors, they tend to take things easy.

6. Being an institute, our teachers maintain discipline whereas, in tuitions conducted by individual professors, they tend to become too friendly with students and take things lightly.

7. When you join private tuitions with different individual professors, their time-table may clash with each other resulting in chaos and tension. This effects the students' performance.

On the other hand, there is no clash of time-table when you join private tuitions conducted by us.
